This class runs for five evenings.

Personal Equipment

Each student will need to provide their own mask, snorkel, fins and wetsuit boots. Because of the personal nature of these items, they are not available for rental. Sea Colony offers a large selection of

quality, state-of-the-art scuba equipment for your needs. While you are a student in our classes, you will receive a generous discount off of our regular retail prices of equipment. With the purchase of your equipment, we guarantee its fit and suitability. Certification
