## Rescue Diver Scuba Program 2020

### Description

"Challenging" and "rewarding" best describe the PADI Rescue Diver course. Building upon what you've already learned, this course expands your knowledge on how to prevent problems and how to manage them if they occur. The fun part about this course is rising to challenges and mastering them. Most divers find becoming a Rescue Diver both demanding and rewarding, and at the end, say it's the best course they've ever taken. The course consists of both classroom and open water components. We typically hold the classroom sessions in our shop on two to three evenings. The open water portion is held at Lake Phoenix.



### Prerequisites

To enroll in a PADI Rescue Diver course, you must be 12 years old or older and already hold an Advanced Open Water Diver certification. You need adequate swimming skills and need to be in good physical health. A medical statement must be completed.

Before a Rescue Diver certification can be issued, you must also show that you are certified in CPR and First Aid (within the past 24 months). If you have never taken a first aid class or your current certification has expired, we typically scheduled a PADI Emergency First Response either before or after the Rescue Diver course lectures.

### What's Included

consisting of lectures, discussion of knowledge reviews and a final exam. Each student will be provided with a Manual.

### Personal Equipment

For the certification dives, each student will need to provide their own mask, snorkel, fins and wetsuit boots. Because of the personal nature of these items, they are not available for rental. Sea Colony offers a large selection of quality, state-of-the-art scuba equipment for your needs. Please refer to the Personal Equipment brochure for more information.

### Certification

Upon proof of CPR/First Aid and completion of the academic sessions, you must participate in various open water exercises and scenarios dives. These can be done in a single weekend with Sea Colony at Lake Phoenix in southern Virginia. The cost of the certification dives is not included in the cost of the course.
